

Warrant Articles for 2021 Consideration

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand One Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$259,180.00) to pave 1.3 miles of road throughout the town and to authorize the withdrawal of Two Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand One Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$259,180.00) from the **Major Road Improvement Capital Reserve Fund** created for that purpose. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. No money to be raised from new taxation.**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) for the purpose of purchasing a dump truck with plow, sander, and two-way radio communication for the Highway Department; and authorize the withdrawal of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) from the **Municipal Truck Capital Reserve Fund** created for that purpose. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. No money to be raised from new taxation.**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) to be added to the **Water Department Capital Reserve Fund** previously established. This sum to come from the Water Unassigned Fund Balance. No amount to be raised from taxation. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. No money to be raised from new taxation.**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) to be added to the **Road Improvement Capital Reserve Fund** previously established. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.15**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Forty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$44,000) to purchase and equip a new police vehicle and authorize the withdrawal of Forty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$44,000) from the **Police Cruiser Capital Reserve Fund** created for that purpose. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.13**

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Forty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$42,000) to offset the Property Inspector-Code Enforcement Officer's salary and expenses with said funds to come from the **Planning Special Revenue Fund**. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. No money to be raised by new taxation.**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) to be added to the **New Land & Building Capital Reserve Fund** previously established. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.09**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty-One Thousand Dollars (\$21,000) to be added to the **Police Cruiser Capital Reserve Fund** previously established. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.06**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) to be added to the **Municipal Truck Capital Reserve Fund** previously established. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.06**

To see if the Town will vote to raise appropriate the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for Transfer Station/Recycling Center Operations with said funds to come from the **Recycling Special Revenue Fund**. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. No money to be raised from new taxation.**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) to be added to the **Highway Equipment Capital Reserve Fund** previously established. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.04**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) for the purpose of off-setting expenses related to ambulance operations, specifically hospital to hospital medical transfers of the sick and injured with said funds to come from the **Fire Department and Ambulance Equipment, Apparatus and Personnel Special Revenue Fund**. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. No money to be raised by new taxation.**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Fourteen Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$14,200) to purchase four (4) Full Matrix Driver Speed Limit Feedback Signs. Said signs to be permanently affixed to existing speed limit signs for year-round traffic control. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.04**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) to be added to the **Landfill Closure Capital Reserve Fund** previously established. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.03**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) to be added to the **Employee Benefits Expendable Trust Fund** for the purpose of funding the benefits upon an employee's retirement or resignation. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.03**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) to be added to the **Computer Technology Capital Reserve Fund** previously established. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to be added to the **Library Improvement Capital Reserve Fund** previously established. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Thousand Sixty-Five Dollars (\$2,065) for the purpose of making the Town's contribution to **North Country Home Health & Hospice Agency Inc.**, to help offset the support of the home health care, supportive care, medical hospice and community health programs and services of North Country Home Health & Hospice Agency, Inc. and Hospice of the Littleton Area for the residents of Carroll. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Nineteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,900) for the purpose of making the Town's contribution for **Tri County Community Action Program** in support of their services for residents in our community. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250) for the purpose of making the Town's contribution to help offset the cost of preventative and primary health care services of **Ammonoosuc Community Health Services, Inc.** provided to the residents of Carroll. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for the purpose of making the Town's contribution to **Court Appointed Special Advocated (CASA) of NH** for recruiting, training and supervising volunteers who advocate in NH's courts for the best interests of abused and neglected children. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for the purpose of making the Town's contribution to **NH North Country Veterans, Inc.** which provides legal guidance, homeless outreach, and other services to veterans in the North Country. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for the purpose of making the Town's contribution to the **Center for New Beginnings** in Littleton which provides counseling and mental health services to individuals throughout the North Country area. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Three Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars (\$356) for the purpose of making the Town's contribution to the **American Red Cross**. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Nine Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars (\$923) for the purpose of making the Town's contribution to the **Northern Human Services – White Mountain Mental Health and Common Ground**, a non-profit mental health and development service center. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Eight Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars and Four Cents (\$888.04) for the purpose of making the Town's contribution to help offset the cost of operating the **Mount Washington Regional Airport**. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation. Tax impact \$.01**

To see if the Town will vote to adopt RSA 41:14-a, to allow the Selectmen to acquire or sell land, buildings or both; provided, however, they shall first submit any such proposed acquisition or sale to the Planning Board and to the Conservation Commission for review and recommendation by those bodies. This article will remain in effect until rescinded by majority vote. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation.**

To see if the Town will vote to sell the Fire Station located at 104 Route 3 North, Parcel ID: 206-023-000-000, for its fair market value. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation.**

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the establishment and implementation of a mandatory Pay-Per-Bag System at the Transfer Station, with the revenue generated to be added to the **Recycling Special Revenue Fund**, and furthermore to adopt this article in accordance with RSA 41:9-a, Establishment of Fees. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation.**

To see if the Town of Carroll will vote to direct the School Board of the White Mountains Regional Cooperative School District to initiate a review of the feasibility and suitability of Carroll's withdrawal from the White Mountain Regional Cooperative School District, pursuant to RSA 195:25? The White Mountain Regional Cooperative School District's warrant includes an article proposing to amend the apportionment formula for the Cooperative School District; this article shall only take effect if that article does not pass in substance as proposed by the Town of Carroll (moving to 80% average daily membership and 20% equalized valuation, over a period of 4 years). If the Cooperative School District's article passes, then this article shall not take effect. **The Board of Selectmen [recommends/does not recommend] this appropriation.**
